### **YOUTH DISCIPLINE POLICY**

In the event that a youth misbehaves during the trip we will follow several steps of discipline:

- 1.) First Offense – Verbal Warning
- 2.) Second Offense – Assignment to an Adult Partner
- 3.) Third Offense – The Youth's Parents will be contacted and requested to come pick-up their son/daughter or to find a way for her/him to return home at the parents expense.

I do not foresee the need to discipline anyone on the trip, but if the need arises these are the steps that will be followed. I reserve the right to skip any of the above steps and go straight to sending a youth home if the seriousness of the behavior warrants it.
